Seminar in Collaboration with Build Your Smile Dental Foundation (BYSDF)

The Equator University of Science & Technology (EQUSat) in collaboration with the Build Your Smile Dental Foundation (BYSDF), organized an expert seminar on Dentistry in Uganda Compared to Global trends. Dental surgeons and health professionals, provided training and guidance to students, focusing on research, dental education, and best practices in oral health care.

Partnership with Build Your Smile Dental Foundation Uganda (BYSDFU)

The Equator University of Science & Technology (EQUSat) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Build Your Smile Dental Foundation Uganda (BYSDFU) to improve dental health outcomes in the Greater Masaka Region.

Following this agreement, the two institutions jointly organized a Mega Dental Camp, offering dental care, screenings, and health education. The collaboration also connected EQUSaT with the Uganda Dental Association (UDA), broadening its health network and enabling future training and research partnerships.
